<u>UNOPPOSED MOTION TO TERMINATE CONSENT ORDER</u> <u>AND DISMISS WITH PREJUDICE</u>

Plaintiffs the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau and the United States of America, by and through undersigned counsel, file this unopposed motion to provide the Court with a status update and to respectfully request termination of the Consent Order and dismissal of this case with prejudice.

The Court entered a Consent Order in this case on September 14, 2022 (ECF 13). The Consent Order states that its requirements will remain in effect for five (5) years or longer if Trident Mortgage Company LP (Trident) has not invested all money required by the order. (*Id.* \P 64). The Order also states that other modifications may be made upon approval of the Court, by motion of any Party. (*Id.* \P 68).

In support of this motion, the United States advises the Court that Trident has demonstrated a commitment to remediation, and:

Trident has fully disbursed the loan subsidy fund (\$18,400,000) as required (*see id.* ¶ 7);

- Trident paid the civil money penalty (\$4,000,000) to the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (*see id.* ¶ 39); and
- 3. Trident is substantially in compliance with the other monetary and injunctive terms of the Consent Order.

We have conferred with Trident and Trident does not oppose the motion.

WHEREFORE, for these reasons, Plaintiffs respectfully request that the Court enter the

attached Order terminating the Consent Order and dismissing this case with prejudice.
